






#### DAY 1

- Lawachara rain forest
- Manipuri Khasia Community
- Tea gardens

## DAY Plan (Wonders of Sreemangal)

Early morning our respective guide will pick you up from the hotel or airport and start driving towards Sreemangal. We will reach approximately at 10.00 am at Lawachara rain forest [Lawachara National Park, located in the Sreemangal area of northeastern Bangladesh, is a remarkable biodiversity hotspot. Covering approximately 1,250 hectares, the park is a semi-evergreen forest that provides a habitat for a wide variety of flora and fauna. It is home to over 460 species of plants, including towering trees, shrubs, and an array of exotic flowers. The park is renowned for its rich wildlife, hosting around 246 species of birds, 20 species of mammals, and numerous reptiles and amphibians.] We will track there for few hours and we will visit the **Tribal village** (monipuri and khashia community) we will know their lifestyle.

After this we will have lunch on ay well known restaurant for local cuisine. Then we will drive for **Madhabpur Lake**. On the way we will see the beauty of tea garden which is so beautiful, then we will see **rubber plantings** and also witness the traditional way of cultivating **pineapples** and lemons.

In the afternoon we will arrive to our next destination which is **Madhabpur Lake** which exists from the British colonial period. The raw beauty of this place can catch any traveler to stop and feel the beauty. Than we will back to your hotel or eco resort.

#### **DAY Plan (Nature of Sylhet)**

Early in the morning we will head for the only swamp forest of the country "ratargul" located in Sylhet where you will get a mesmerizing boat ride through the deep green forest. Ratargul is often referred to as the "Amazon of Bangladesh." The forest is submerged underwater during the monsoon season, creating a magical landscape of half-submerged trees and tranquil waterways. At the middle of the day we will have lunch and drive to Lalakhal which is renowned for its mesmerizing natural beauty and crystal-clear, turquoise-blue waters. The specialty of Lalakhal lies in its vibrant, pristine waters, which change color based on the depth and sunlight, creating a stunning visual spectacle. It will be a boat joy ride.

With this we will complete the journey and head back to Dhaka which will take approximately 5/6 hours. Overnight stay in Dhaka.

#### DAY Plan (mesmerizing Dhaka city)

This day morning at 08.00 am the respective tour guide with driver will pick up from the hotel and proceed to visit **Kawran Bazar**, one of the largest vegetables, fruits and fish market in Dhaka City. Here we explore everyday market activates located by the **train track**. After visiting this we will stop by **National Parliament Building** (We will visit outside the parliament) then we have lunch in front of **Lalbagh Fort** and visit the fort. After this we will visit **Dhakeshwari Temple**, National Monument and **Curzon Hall**. **Armenian Church**, **Star Mosque & Husssaini Dalan**. Now we head to chaotic Old Dhaka. We walk through some colorful lanes, market and narrow streets to see the typical lifestyles of Dhaka's people. After that we'll visit the **historical Ahsan Manzil** (Pink Palace). After this we will walk through **Sadarghat Boat Terminal** and then we cross the river to **shipyard** by a rowing boat. After exploring the ship repairing and wrecking yard we will take a boat back to Sadarghat.

Then heading for Barishal.

#### DAY Plan (witness the reverine Bangladesh)

Early morning you will arrive at **Barisal** and this day you will visit **backwaters market** and see many wooden boats with full of goods like Vegetable / Rice / Guava are ready for trading on the water, mile after mile you will enjoy these water ways inside the canal and watch both side **panoramic** view of the remote **village scenery**, you will cruise in the river and small canals and visit **floating market** which is full of activates and perfect for **photography!** Then drive towards **Bagerhat** and visit **the 15th century Muslim** City once called as **Khalifabad** which is the present day Bagerhat, is an **UNESCO** protected world heritage site. Stay overnight at Khulna.

## DAY Plan (18th century's creation of Queen Bhavani)

We will start from your hotel at 7 am. For an enriching day tour exploring the historical and architectural wonders of **Rajshahi**. We will visit **Natore Rajbari** (**Queen Bhovani Palace**), where you can admire the grandeur of this historical palace and its intricate designs. Next, head to the **Puthia Temple Complex**, an **18th-century** archaeological marvel featuring several temples showcasing unique **terracotta** art and traditional Hindu architectural styles. Within the Puthia Temple Complex, visit the **Pancha Ratna Govinda** Temple, known for its exquisite ornamentation and impressive five-spire structure. Close by, you'll find the **Bhubaneshwar Shiva Temple**, an architectural masterpiece dedicated to Lord Shiva, featuring detailed carvings and a serene atmosphere. Continue your journey to the **Jagannath Temple**, another remarkable structure within the complex, distinguished by its ornate decorations and historical significance. Finally, conclude your tour at the **Chota Anhik Mandir**. After that will start to drive for Naogaon. Overnight stay.

This grand **Buddhist monastic** complex, renowned for its architectural splendor, provides a profound glimpse into ancient Buddhist culture and learning. Next, delve into the 7th century at **Gukol Medh**, an

archaeological marvel that reveals fascinating insights into the region's historical narrative. Continue your journey to **Mohasthangarh**, one of Bangladesh's oldest archaeological sites founded in the **3rd century BC**. Explore the remnants of this ancient fortified city, which once thrived as a major urban and administrative center. Conclude your tour with a visit to the Mohasthangarh Archaeological Museum, where you can peruse a rich collection of artifacts, relics, and exhibits that chronicle the site's extensive history and the civilizations that once flourished there. **Then drive back to Dhaka.**
